Write a haiku about a pink flamingo(s):



Inspired by a conversation with Martha and Patrick's students.

Your haiku should:

- * Include the subject: pink flamingo
- * Be written in three lines
- * Seventeen or fewer syllables (11-14 is ideal for English language haiku)
- * Strive for 10 or fewer words
- * Avoid simile, rhyme and personification

Note:

Haiku generally paint a picture with words and do not tell the reader what to feel or think. Except for proper nouns, capital letters are avoided, as is most punctuation.

Entry guidelines:

- * 1 haiku per participant
- * Your haiku should include your name and grade.
- * Type your haiku in the body of an email (no attachments please) sent to: painting.tom@paideiaschool.org or hand deliver to Tom in the junior high.
